

High School Fundamentals: This course provides a foundation in skills for successful organization, communication, and general tools and skills students need to be successful in the 9th grade. In addition, students will explore future college and career opportunities.

Open to: Incoming 9th grade students

Credit: .5 Pass/Fail (Elective Credit)

Parent meeting for students attending High School Fundamentals will be held Thursday, July 6th at 6:00 p.m. in the BHS Commons.

ACT Test Prep: This course is designed to assist students in preparing for the ACT assessment test. There will be 2 days focusing on English/Reading and 2 days focusing on Math. Students attending the test prep course are encouraged to register for the ACT test given at TCT on Saturday, June 10. Registration deadline for the ACT is May 5.

Open to: 10th, 11th & 12th grade students

Credit: Not for Credit

Prep for Accelerated English - Path to AP: Students will be guided through the summer reading project through the use of class discussion, notes and independent work time. In addition this course will provide a foundation in the skills for successful analysis, argument, annotation and synthesis of text - in all major genres: poetry, nonfiction, fiction and drama. Participation will provide students an overview of the literary and rhetorical skills that encompass the range of argument and synthesis of text. Completion of this course provides the necessary preparation for Pre-AP English 9 or Pre-AP English 10.

Open to: Incoming 9th & 10th grade students

Credit: Not for Credit

Fundamentals of Composition: This course provides a foundation in skills for writing essays. Students will write for varied purposes and audiences using narrative, informative, and argumentative modes, fully-developed ideas, strong organization, well-chosen words, fluent sentences, and appropriate voice.

Dates: M - F, July 10 - 28

Time: 8:30 - 1:00

Open to: Incoming 9th & 10th grade students

Credit: .5 Pass/Fail (Elective Credit)
